

## CMGA MEMBERSHIP MEETING

March 04, 2017

Meeting called to order at 01:30 PM by Jim Werlinger, Vice-President.

Proposed changes to the CMGA By-Laws was the first topic.

Article 13 section 2 change to require only a handicap to play in the major tournaments was made as a motion by Jay Mays, seconded by several members, and was approved.

Article 9 tenure of officers from one year to two years with President and Vice-President elected in odd years and Secretary and Treasurer elected in even years was made as a motion and revised to this content, was seconded by several members, and was approved.
